

## Accessible, Affordable Buses available! Volunteer Class 4 Drivers needed!

Everyone, at any age, benefits from time outdoors. Seniors often have transportation challenges that limit their access to places of interest, so WSH Partners are working together to pool their assets to take seniors on more outings this spring and summer.

The ASK Friendship Society has 9 and 18 seat passenger buses, that are wheelchair accessible with high visibility drop down steps, handrails and 3-point seatbelts. ASK is renting these buses below commercial rates to help cover maintenance and insurance costs. If your community organization knows of a driver with a Class 4 license, ASK will provide them with an orientation for insurance purposes... and your favourite field trip can happen at an affordable price!

If you know any retired bus drivers or someone with an Unrestricted Class 4 license, suggest an outing for seniors organized by your church, neighbourhood house or seniors centre, for example. Ask your community organization to connect with Kara Turner at ASK about renting one of their buses.
